Now, therefore, we, the Lake County Board of Commissioners, declare that a state of emergency exists in the county and that we hereby invoke and declare those portions of the Indiana Code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance to this proclamation, to be in full force and effect in the county for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for protection with a minimum of interruption. Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances and resolutions, and particularly to Section 10-4-1-23 of the Indiana Code. All public officers and employees of Lake County are hereby directed to exercise the utmost the discharge of duties of them for the duration of the emergency and in execution of emerge regulations, and directives—state and local. All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in execution of emergency operations plans, and obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.
