**We DO NOT ACCEPT any letters written to the child. Any correspondence should be mailed to: Lake County Juvenile Justice Complex

We DO NOT ACCEPT gun, hunting or anything related to weaponry magazines, music magazines of any kind; "Low Rider," "Source," or "National Geographic" magazines; karate, wrestling or related magazines, and tabloids such as "Star," and "National Enquirer." We WILL NOT ACCEPT any publications that depict graphic sex and/or violence or any publications containing suggestive pictures.

We DO NOT ACCEPT newspapers, news magazines or any puzzle books.

We DO NOT ACCEPT any hardback books (Including Bibles).

Furthermore, we DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Pictures or photographs**
- Food or snacks**
- Soaps or shampoos**
- Non-prescription medicine**
- Spiral notebooks, writing paper or writing utensils (such as pencils)**

Staples MUST BE REMOVED from items before they will be accepted.

We WILL ACCEPT soft back books and playing cards. The child's name should be written on each item.

We WILL ACCEPT medication specifically prescribed for the child. A Chain of Possession form must be filled out by the Nurse or Intake Officer on duty.

We WILL ACCEPT homework and school books for residents that have been approved by the Education Department. A separate sign-in sheet must be filled out specifically for these materials.

All ACCEPTED property must be signed in by the Security Officer and the person bringing in the property.

The Security Officer on duty will advise as to the acceptability of the property.
