

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Registered Lake County voter
- Student age 16–17 eligible for student poll worker program (*judge, clerk, counter, and elections customer service only*)
- Demonstrated party affiliation or waiver from local party chairs

FAQ

IS TRAINING REQUIRED/PAID?

YES for most positions. See individual descriptions for details.

WHERE WILL I BE WORKING?

LCBER-ONLY: ballot counter, election assistant

LCBER & OFFSITE: travel board, voting technician

ONE POLLING LOCATION IN LAKE COUNTY: early voting, inspector, judge, clerk

**most staff work in their preferred community locations*

HOW LONG DO THESE JOBS LAST?

1-2 DAYS: inspector, judge, election-day clerk, ballot counter, election assistant

3-6 WEEKS: voting technician, early voting, travel board

HOW MUCH WILL I EARN?

Pay varies, but some averages:

\$1,000+: technician, early voting

\$150-500: travel board

\$145-240: ballot counter, election assistant, inspector, clerk, judge

WHEN/HOW DO I GET PAID?

Technicians and early voting clerks: paid bi-weekly via direct-deposit.

All others: Paper checks mailed six weeks after work concludes.

DO I HAVE TO PICK A PARTY?

State law requires bipartisan election staff. To qualify for a party, you must: 1. Have requested a Democrat or Republican primary ballot or 2. Get a waiver from the local party chair. *Student workers are exempt.*

CAN STUDENTS WORK?

HS students 16-17 years old with at 3.0+ GPA are eligible to serve as judge, clerks, ballot counters, and elections assistants. An application and fully-completed training are required before serving. *Eligible positions are noted in red throughout pamphlet.*

CAN I LEAVE A POLL DURING VOTING HOURS?

No. Poll workers may take breaks, but must remain behind the chute the entire time the poll is open.

This leadership position manages all aspects of a specific polling location including setup, breakdown, and staff.

KEY TASKS

- Manages assigned precinct
- Picks up supplies at Lake County Government Center
- Notifies all poll workers of setup times and plans
- Administers oath to all assigned precinct poll workers
- Returns supplies with opposite party judge and completes final paperwork

LOCATION

- *Equipment pickup:* Lake County Government Center
- *Equipment dropoff:* One of three assigned centers; Gary Airport, Wicker Park, or Lake County Government Center
- *Poll:* One of 180 locations across Lake County

Complete a **mandatory** 1-hour online training session

Supply pickup at the Lake County Government Center

Preliminary setup at polling location (one hour)

VOTING TECHNICIAN

6 weeks



The LCBER deploys and manages over 1,000 voting machines, wireless systems, iPads, and ADA equipment. Election mechanics service these machines, in our offices and at polling locations.

ACTIVITY LEVEL

Moderate to high



KEY TASKS

- Perform preventive maintenance and programming on election equipment, including iPads, hotspot/cradlepoints, printers, and ADA equipment
- Assemble all election supplies
- Assist with on-site tech support at early voting and election day polling locations
- Secure and inventory all equipment post-election

LOCATION

LCBER voting machines office in Crown Point
Polling locations as assigned for service calls

TIME COMMITMENT

From Monday, 9/21 through Friday, 11/06/26

M-F, 8:30am-4:30pm with potential overtime

Exception days include:

- 10/24: 7am-2pm
- 10/31 (*inspector Saturday*): 7am-2pm
- 11/02 (*day before election*): 8:30am-8pm
- 11/03 (*election day*): 5am-9pm or later

BALLOT COUNTER/SCANNER

1 day



Each election, the LCBER receives up to **12k ballots by mail**. As a ballot counter, you will be working on bi-partisan teams to process all absentee ballots.

- People who prefer a primarily seated position
- Anyone who likes focused, detail-oriented work

KEY TASKS

- Signature verification
- Processing absentee ballots

TIME COMMITMENT

By Monday, 11/2/26

- Shifts typically last 8 hours.

JUDGE/CLERK

2 days



Election judge escorts voters to and maintains voting machines.



Election clerks greet voters and confirm their eligibility on poll pads.

KEY TASKS

- Escorts voters to and helps operate voting machines
- Helps tally voting machines
- *Republican judge only*: return supplies with Inspector
- Verifies voter ID
- Assists with poll list sign-in
- Provides paperwork for voter address changes

EARLY VOTING

5 weeks



The LCBER operates 11 early-voting sites across Lake County. Bi-partisan elections staff perform all general pollworker functions during early voting.

- Polling location setup
- Verify voter registration ID
- Poll list sign-in
- Assist with voting machines
- Help voters with voting and registration changes
- Site breakdown

LOCATION

(Training) LCBER

TIME COMMITMENT

Week of 9/28/26

Complete paid trainings on site at LCBER

Meet LCBER staff at polling site to receive supplies and set up polling location (typically 1 hour)

Staff a polling location during the following hours:

LCBER only

Monday, 11/2/26

8:30/9am-noon: conclude early voting

TRAVEL BOARD

3-5 days



When we say we want to reach every eligible voter, we mean it! As a travel board member, you'll serve on a bipartisan team that takes a voting machine directly to qualified confined voters.

PERFECT FOR...

- Stay-at-home caregivers
- People looking for flexible work that fits easily into a busy day

ACTIVITY LEVEL

Low to moderate



KEY TASKS

- Pick up equipment at LCBER
- Drive voting machines to assigned locations
- Set up the machines for the voter
- Assist voter as needed and allowed with their ballot
- Return equipment to the LCBER

LOCATION

- Varies by voter need, but are spread across Lake County nursing homes, hospitals, rehab facilities, and individual homes

PAY RATE

- \$60 per day
- Drivers earn \$0.725 per mile

TIME COMMITMENT

By Wednesday, 10/14/26

- Complete a 1-hour in-person training at LCBER
- If driving, provide proof of valid insurance and current drivers licences

Thursday, 10/15/26 to Monday, 11/02/26

- Worker must arrive at LCBER by 9am for supply pickup and return by 3pm for supply dropoff
- Dates and times of voter visits are flexible
