FORM OF PUBLIC QUESTION

“Shall School Town of Munster continue to impose increased property taxes paid to the school corporation by homeowners and businesses for eight (8) years immediately following the holding of the referendum for the purpose of funding current and anticipated educational programs that engage and develop students, retaining and attracting teachers, educational staff, and other support staff, funding operational expenditures including health, security and technology needs and special education, and managing class sizes at a continued maximum tax rate not to exceed \$0.4196 per one hundred dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation? The property tax increase requested in this referendum was originally approved by the voters in May, 2017, and originally increased the average property tax paid to the school corporation per year on a residence within the school corporation by 53.1% and originally increased the average property tax paid to the school corporation per year on a business property within the school corporation by 49.0%”
